- * Contestant must be single, never have been married, and never had children
- * Contestant must be between the ages of 16 and 21 by the pageant date, and not turn 22 before February, 2006.
- * A photographer will be available to take package pictures. No one will be allowed to take photos at or around the photographer's area. **THIS IS PROHIBITED.** Each contestant will receive a FREE 10 X 13 Color Canvas Portrait.
- * Portrait packages will be available for you to purchase in Nuckolls Hall on the Fairgrounds at a later date.
- * Contestants must attend practice (NO EXCEPTIONS).
- * Practice will be July 28, 2006 at Richlands Middle School from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m.
- * Judging: Contestants will be judged on Individual Interview, high Fashion Wear and Evening Gown. Only the Top 10 will have to answer an on-stage question. A copy of the questions will be given out at practice.
- * The entry fee is \$25.00. This may be paid by ONE sponsor and must be for the exact amount of the entry fee.
- * All checks are to be made payable to the Tazewell County Fair Association. The entry fee must be paid by the beginning of practice time. There will be NO REFUNDS. Mail check and application to: Tazewell County Fair Pageants, 515 Fairgrounds Road, Tazewell, VA 24651.
- * The entry fee must be paid by the practice date and before starting time. There will be NO REFUNDS of entry fees.
- * All proceeds will go to the Tazewell County Fair Association.
- * Deadline for application and entry fee is July 28, 2006 before the practice starts.
- * Professional Pageant judges will be employed.

Miss Tazewell County Fair will receive a \$1,000 Scholarship Award, Crown, Trophy, Banner, flowers, and \$50 Cash . She will also qualify to participate in the Miss Virginia Association of Fairs Pageant.

Rules for Winner

* The legal residency of each contestant will be verified prior to the pageant. Any questions about your residency must be answered to the satisfaction of the Tazewell County Fair Association Attorney before contestant is allowed to participate. If you or anyone else

intentionally provides false information pertaining to your legal residency, you will be stripped of your crown, title, and be required to repay the \$50 prize money and be responsible for any legal fees that were incurred by the Tazewell County Fair Association.

The 2006 Miss Tazewell County Fair will be required to do the following:

1. Attend the Fair at times requested by the Tazewell County Fair Officials. The queen must wear her crown and banner at all times when present on the fairgrounds. The Queen will be expected to abide by the Dress Code and Code of Conduct approved by the Fair Board.
2. The queen must make herself available for presentations, award ribbons, trophies, etc... as required by the Tazewell County Fair Officials. If NO request is made, then the queen is free to enjoy the fair but must remain on the fairgrounds for the specified time. Appropriate behavior is expected at all times.
4. The Queen is required to sign and abide all Conduct and Dress Code rules. The copy of the conduct and dress code rules may be viewed at the Tazewell County Fair Office.
5. The reigning 2006 Miss Tazewell County Fair will be allowed to participate in other pageants.
6. As the 2006 Miss Tazewell County Fair, she may ride in any of the county-wide parades (Christmas, Homecoming, etc.) that she wishes but she will be responsible for obtaining her own transportation, making her own signs, and notifying the coordinator of the parade of her intentions.
7. If the winner is under 18 years of age, a chaperone (approved by the Fair Board) must accompany her during all of her official appearances.
8. If any pay is offered for any appearance, whether it be a flat fee, mileage, etc., all negotiations will be handled by the Fair Office. *By signing this application you are hereby agreeing to abide by all rules as set forth by the TCFA and hereby release TCFA, Members, Board of Directors, Pageant Staff, and Pageant Facility, from any and all claims of damages directly or indirectly resulting from the named contestants participating in this pageant. I agree to follow all the rules and CONDUCT MYSELF IN A GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP MANNER. Bad sportsmanship will not be tolerated. ALL JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.*

Dress Code for Miss Tazewell Co. Fair and for the Junior Miss Tazewell Co. Fair

- All attire must be in good taste at all times.
- Undergarments must be worn at all times and must be covered at all times.
- No bra-less look, see through apparel, tube tops, strapless tops, or mid-cut shirts or tops. Tank tops straps must be two fingers in width.
- Shirts must be tucked in or cover waist when arms are extended overhead.
- No plunging necklines where cleavage is visible.
- No graffiti or gang related messages of any kind on clothing, jewelry or personal belongings.
- Garments worn on the bottom half must be at or above the navel.
- Shorts and skorts may be worn if they are finger tip length.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times. Due to health and safety concerns, closed toe shoes must be worn at livestock and arena events.
- No strapless dresses will be allowed.
- No body piercing will be visible at any time(excluding ear piercing).
- Tattoos must be covered.
